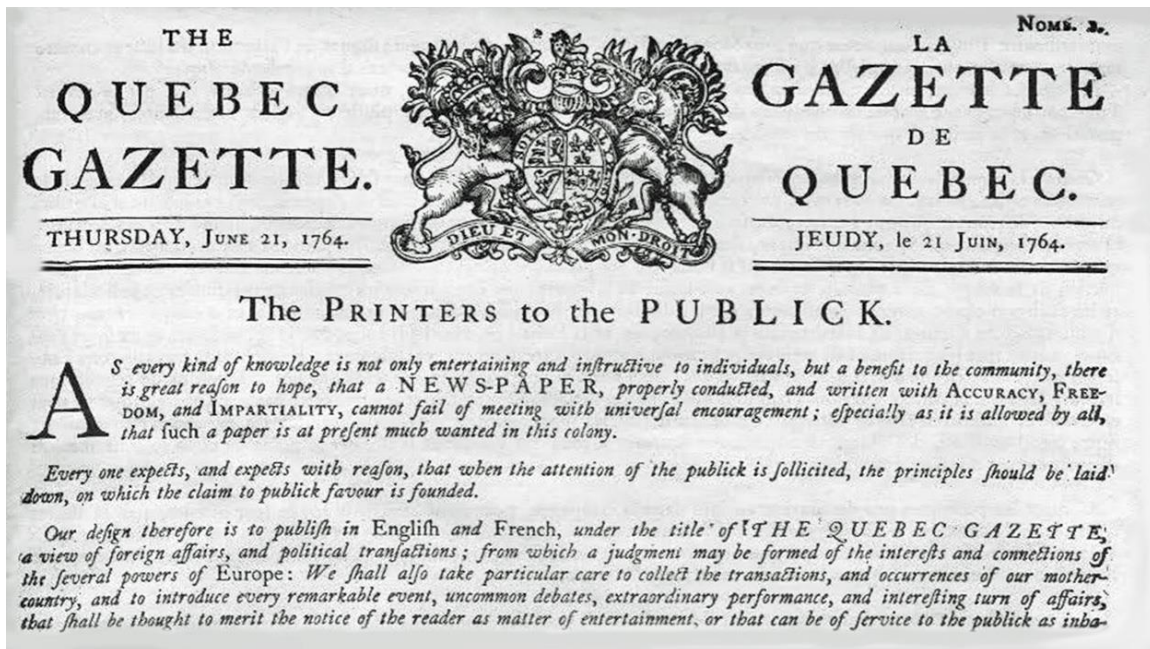

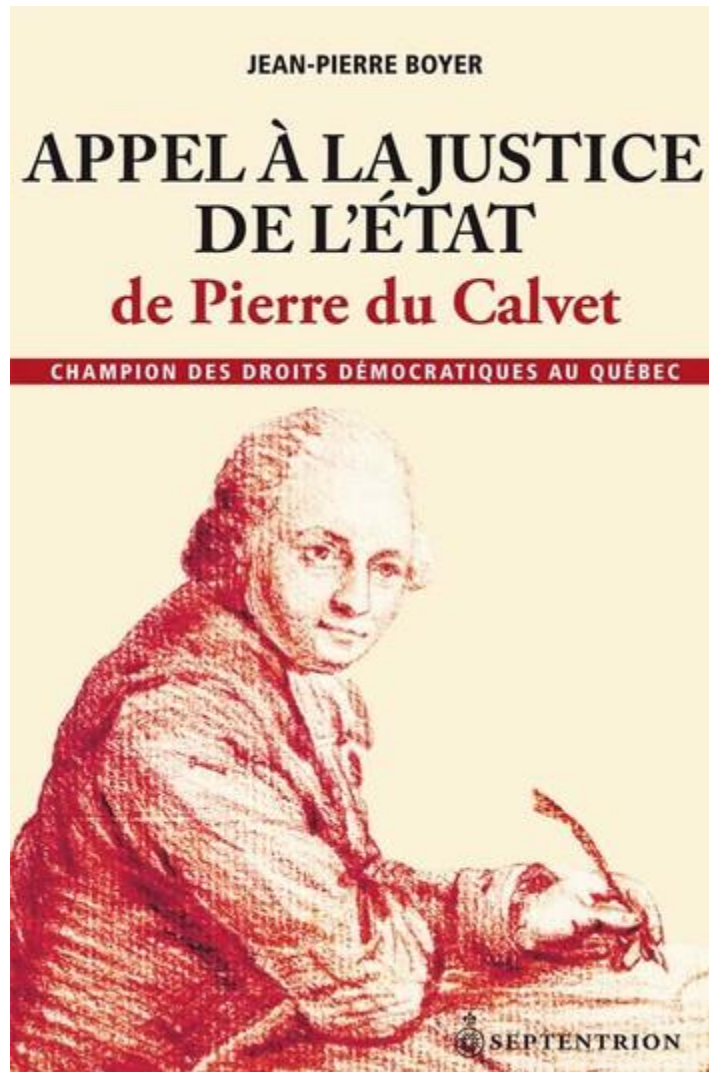


Fleury Mesplet

1735-1786

Justice of the peace at the Court of Common Pleas for the district of Montréal. His public denunciation of the abuses of justice by certain judges among his colleagues attracted him both friends and enemies.

In 1784, he published *The Case of Peter du Calvet* to let his cause be known.

Céline Cyr – Michel Bibaud, teacher, journalist, author, poet, essayist, office holder, justice of the peace and owner of Magasin du Bas-Canada – In 1817, Bibaud formed L'Aurore newspaper with Joseph-Victor Delorme and in 1819, he founded Le Courrier du Bas-Canada in partnership with Joseph Delorme. In 1825, Bibaud organized the Journal littéraire et scientifique in Montréal, the latter was also referred to as La Bibliothèque Canadienne or Miscellanées historiques, scientifiques et littéraires. In 1830, Bibaud in partnership with Ludger Duvernay organized L'Observateur newspaper.
