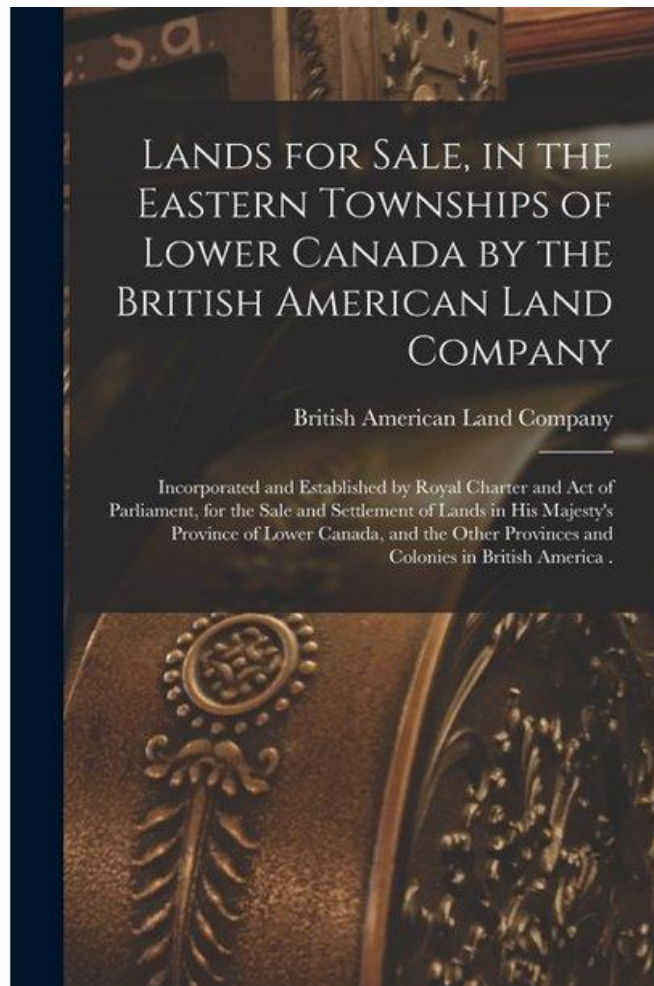

Emigrants and Natives in Search of Lands for Settlement

June 20th, 1842

The British American Land Company incorporated by Royal Charter, and Act of Parliament, offer for sale several farms, partly cleared and cultivated and ready for immediate occupation. Town Lots and Mill Sites, and seven hundred thousand acres of Wild Land, in portions of any extent from fifty acres, upwards.

These properties are situated in the District of Saint Francis, in the Eastern Townships on the south side of Canada, one of the most beautiful, fertile, healthy portions of British America. They are held under the Socage Tenure, direct from the Crown and free of all Feudal burden whatsoever.

These Townships are centrally situated at a distance from fifty to eighty miles from Quebec and Montreal. They are well watered everywhere, possessed of excellent roads, and diversified with pretty lakes and fishy streams and rivers.

The soil is equal in fertility to that of any part of the Continent, the appearance of the country is highly picturesque, and the climate is eminently salubrious. There are saw and grist mills, mechanic's shops, smiths, foundry, woolen manufactory, academies, schools, churches of all denominations, and a college is being built.

Every description of grain and root crops cultivated in Great Britain is found to succeed well in this district, and corn, cattle, horses, sheep, and pigs are raised with great advantage, as articles of export to the neighbouring seaport towns.

The Company sell their lands at very reasonable prices, and on an indulgent credit, six years being allowed to pay up the annual instalments. To such persons as can prepay thirty dollars, the fifth instalment of a lot or farm of 100 acres, they grant a free transport for their families and luggage, not (exceeding 8 cwt.) from Montreal, Quebec, or the St. Lawrence to Sherbrooke; and, if on arrival there, they think they can do better than purchase from the Company, they will return them the money, retaining only the proportion of it actually expended on themselves.

To such persons of respectable character as have come out under the present depression and have no money, they grant permission on credit to settle on new land, and to form at once an independent family home, in which case, no money is required down; they sell most excellent settling land at about ten shillings per acre, and when enregistered, becomes the most free and sure holding under the Crown.

There is, generally, a fair demand for hired labour in these Townships, at good wages both for men and women, the Gosford Road affords present employment

for destitute emigrants; and parents blessed with large families, can generally subsist themselves and half their children by the hire of the other half, during the first winter, while they are clearing and preparing for crop, the lot which they may have selected, from the Company on credit, as their future family home.

The Company's property is accessible by the roads from Quebec, Montreal and Sorel, but the route most easily travelled at present is that from Port Saint Francis through Drummondville to Melbourne and Sherbrooke. The stage fare is about 3d. per mile for each cwt.

The Company have agents in the several sections of the district itself, as well as at the ports of landing, for the convenient local sale of land, and for the advice, protection, and encouragement of their settlers.

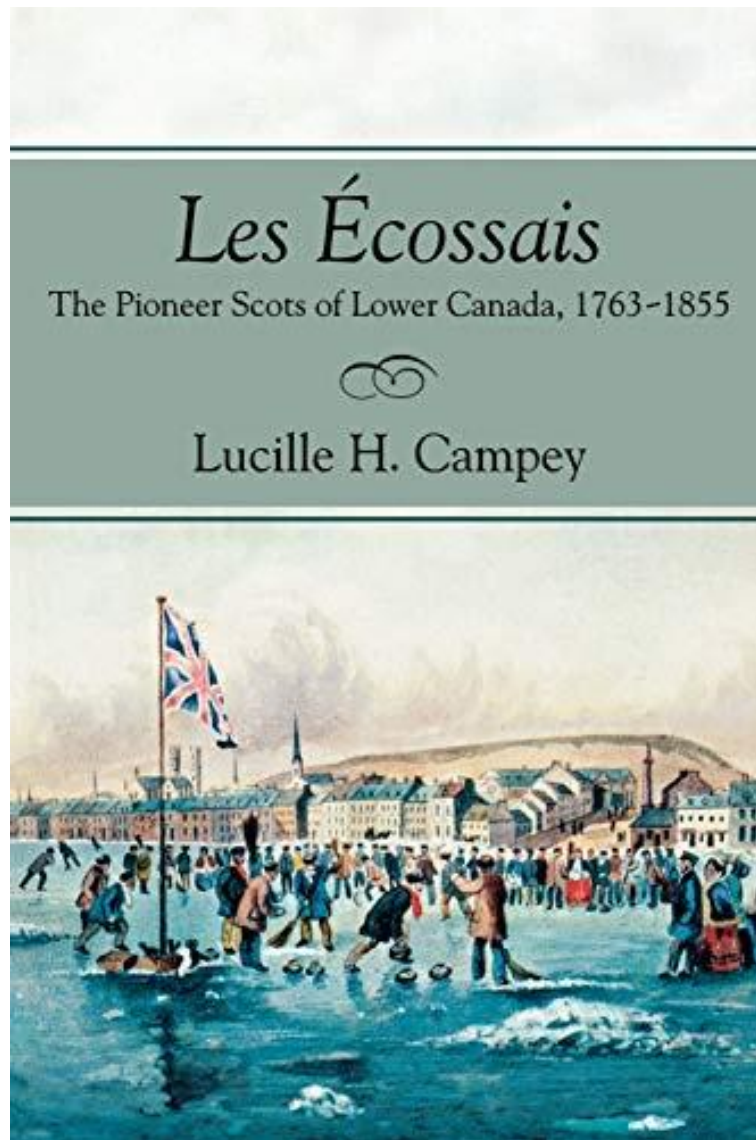

Canadian pastoral: promotional images of British colonization in Lower Canada's Eastern Townships during the 1830s

Lower Canada's largely American-settled Eastern Townships during the 1830s. As part of its strategy to stimulate British migration to the region, the imperial government had sold most of the remaining crown land to the London-based British American Land Company. The image that emerges from the letters and testimonials printed in the company's colonization brochures is of a picturesque and healthful environment ideally suited to pastoral agriculture. That image stamped the region with the imperial aesthetic landscape during a politically turbulent era, but it would have little practical appeal to the vast majority of British immigrants who continued up the St Lawrence to Upper Canada where they could produce the cash crops that would facilitate their economic independence.

Collectif (various authors) – 1764-1841 - Land Petitions Lower Canada (Québec) - The Records - In the province of Québec, land distribution was originally based on the seigneurial system, established in 1627 and used until 1854. Seigneuries were granted by the King to members of the bourgeoisie, members of important families or former military officers. As proprietor of a seigneurie, the seigneur had privileges and obligations towards the King or his representative. The seigneur granted parcels (concessions) of his land to tenants called *censitaires* or more commonly, *habitants*. Starting in 1763, new lands were granted according to the township system. Quebec was divided into counties that were divided into townships or *municipalités de paroisses*. The British North America Act of 1867 established Crown lands as a provincial responsibility. Only

land petitions for Upper and Lower Canada (Ontario and Quebec) were retained by the Government of Canada. > Library and Archives Canada / Bibliothèque Archives Canada
